PSDF Final Exam:

On July 30th, 2024, the Punjab Board of Technical Education (PBTE) conducted exams for the PSDF-sponsored courses. These courses include a 3-month program for Electrician, Amazon VA, Home Appliances Repairing, Hand Embroidery, Mobile Phone Repairing, Mobile Phone Repairing (Hybrid), Plumber, and AutoCAD. Out of 171 eligible students, 160 appeared and successfully passed the exam. The entire examination process was overseen by a Third-Party Monitor (TPM) from the Punjab Skills Development Fund (PSDF) and PBTE-nominated examiners.



Conduction of NAVTTC RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning):

As a partner of NAVTTC, SMIT conducted the assessment for three NAVTTC RPL trades: Beautician, Dress Making, and Computer Operator. These trades are specifically designed for trained and skilled females.
